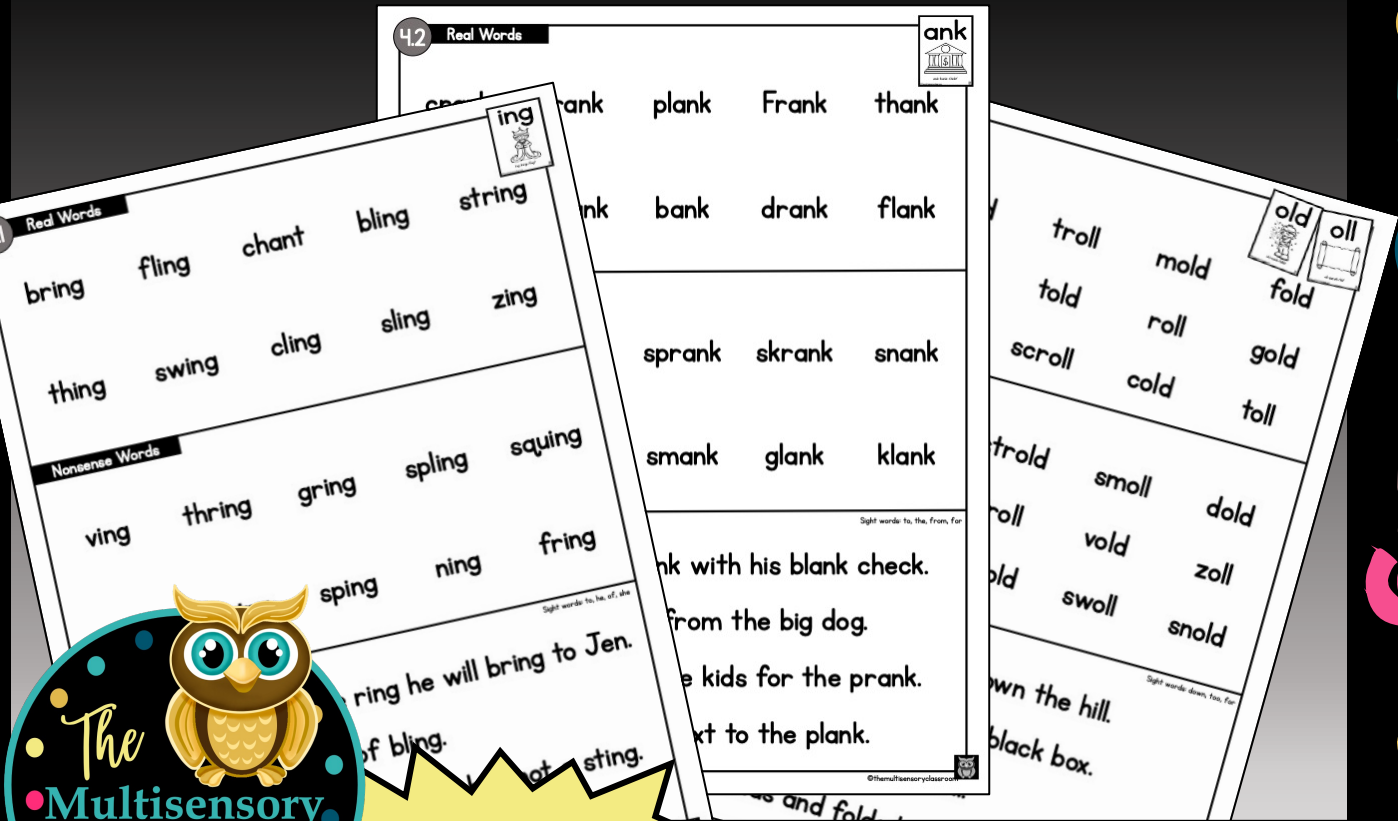

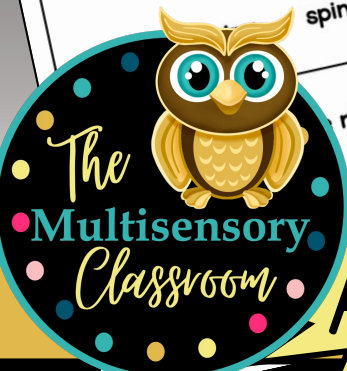

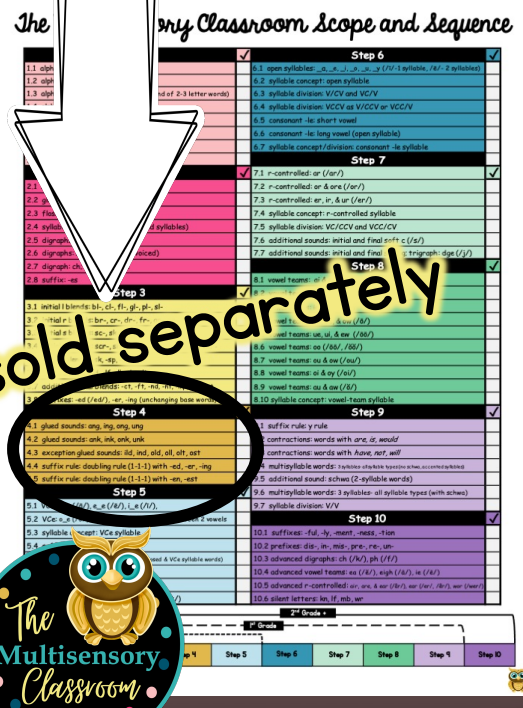

### Aligned Instructions for Orton Gillingham Decodable Word Lists and Sentences

**To use with *The Multisensory Classroom Scope and Sequence* or any reading curriculum:**  
Find the sub-step on *The Multisensory Classroom Scope and Sequence* that contains the phonogram or skill and then locate the page of words and sentences with the same sub-step number and phonogram/skill.

The *Multisensory Classroom Scope and Sequence* is divided into 10 main steps.

Each step is divided into multiple sub-steps; each sub-step introduces one or more phonograms or skill(s).

All eight words (any words containing phonograms not yet introduced in the scope and sequence) are listed in the top right corner of the "Sentences" section.

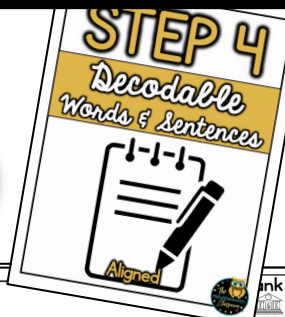
